PRESENTATION NIGHT & Evening Entertainment Venue: MORUYA GOLF CLUB: Friday & Sat Night: free entertainment. **The Presentation night will be held at the club Saturday Night from 7pm.** Before & during the presentation there will be entertainment for the kids. A three course roast dinner will be available from 6pm \$15 adults \$8 kids 12 & under. After the presentation there will be free entertainment for the rest of the night. Their will be a free courtesy bus service running Saturday Night to take you to & from the club. MARSHAL'S BUS & COACH SERVICES: will be available Sat morning to go to the markets leaving the Speedway at 10am returning at 12 noon & Saturday night from 5:30 PM picking up from Barlings beach to Moruya, time table is enclosed.

BURNOUTS: Entrants in the Burnouts must have a 360 degree tail shaft loop fitted. A 360- degree loop is compulsory as it is possible for the tail shaft to spear through the floor of the car. Yes this dose mean Commodores have to have one they do fit. Don't forget an approved helmet & fire extinguisher is also required.

JUDGING: your vehicle will be judged were it is displayed; all areas of your vehicle must be accessible to the judges I.E. if its locked up they cannot judge the interior or engine bay. Your sticker will be crossed when your vehicle has been judged try to get your vehicle Judged before entering any of the driving events. Judging will start from 9AM Saturday Morning until 3PM your vehicle must be Judged on Saturday, if by 2.30 pm Sat your vehicle has not been judged see the judges in the show N Shine area & they will judge your vehicle. Your car must still be at the event on show Sunday as all final judging for some awards will be done then. The judge's results are final.

WARNING: No Heavily intoxicated patrons will be permitted on the courtesy bus to ensure the safety of the other passengers. No drinking, eating or smoking is permitted on the courtesy bus.

Any Bad behavior will not be tolerated the offenders will be told to get off the bus.

What you need to do to enter the event

Carefully Read the entire entry form & advise sheet thoroughly before signing.

Complete the entire entry form filling in & signing every applicable section.

Any well presented vehicle can enter the event. (This means no body damage or patch work paint).

Read all the rules. They must be obeyed or you could be escorted from the event.

Partners competing in driving events must sign a part of the entry form, read & agree to the conditions of entry & sign all disclaimers. If we don't have your details you will not be able to compete in the events.

There is no extra charge for your partners competing in the events.

Support vehicles: Must be towing entered vehicle or carrying parts/display gear for the entered vehicle. Details of the support vehicle must be included on this entry form once inside the venue support vehicles must remain static until leaving. Any extra person/s must have pre paid buddy pass or pay full spectator entry fee.

Some Important Rules & Requirements are:

Vehicles entering driving events will be scrutineered for safety prior to the driving event.

All entrants in driving events may be breath tested just before participating in each event your blood alcohol level must be **0.00** for each event. **No Alcohol is to be brought into the venue.**

No glass containers of any type are permitted in the Surfair Speedway Complex during the event. **No fires** are to be lit in the Speedway Complex during the event.

Burn - Outs or spinning your wheels **any where** other than during the driving events in the specified areas will result in you being escorted from the event. You may also be charged by the Police & your vehicle impounded. Please respect the Speedway Grounds. The future of the event depends on it.

Any bad or dangerous behaviour will not be tolerated & will result in you being told to leave.

This is a family event with a strong reputation for running a safe & secure event & not putting up with any misbehaviour whatsoever. There are no second chances you have received the warnings when you complete this form. Misbehaviour or not following the direction of the event marshals, Security Staff, Event Officials, Management or the Police will result in the offender/s being escorted out of the event & banned from entering the following year's event. It may also result in you being charged by the Police. Vehicles must be clean & tidy with no body damage, rust or patchy paint.

Current registration & third party insurance papers should be carried at all times.

Highly Modified Cars must carry engineer's reports especially if driving out side the venue.

There are **noise restrictions** inside the venue no noise is to exceed 95 DB, you must abide by the Roads

& Traffic Authorities laws outside the speedway. This includes the Street Cruise. You must run legal so

don't drop your pipes.

Burnout participants must have a 360 degree tail shaft loop fitted. Entrants must wear an approved helmet, wear long pants, long sleeve shirt or jacket, Shoes & socks must also be worn. Also carry a fire extinguisher. All burnouts are to be done one way down the track to the donut area, do not come back up the track towards the marshal's. Try not to do static burnouts as you will be disqualified, when completed or if you blow your tyres exit the track with caution, don't spin your rims, follow the directions of the officials to the tyre changing area. Burn Out Participants must also comply with NSW Sports & Recreation regulations please read regulations carefully.

When moving within the event from one place to another it must be at a walking pace only, please use

common sense & obey all instructions given by officials.

Entrance sticker & Wrist bands: Entrance stickers must be on your windscreen to gain entry to the event, wrist bands must be worn at all times, broken wrist bands will not be accepted & you may be refused entry if for any reason you cannot medically wear a wrist band call us so we can make other arrangements.

A message from the Police the police totally support the event & will do every thing within their power to make sure the event is a success & the future of the event is secure. The Police have & will use the power to confiscate vehicles involved in illegal activities inside the event as well as out side the event. The Police can & will issue infringements to anyone breaking any laws inside or outside the event. Random breath testing will also be conducted over the weekend of the event. The Police will also pick a police choice award.

A Message from the Promoters & Management any deliberate damage to the grounds or property within the Speedway will result in the offender/s paying all costs for the repair of the damage. EG: spinning your wheels deliberately digging holes, your respect for the area will ensure the future of the event.

Entrants vehicles remain at the venue for the duration of the event each day unless its an emergency to leave.

All marshals & entrants must comply with Competition Conditions required by Sports & Rec as well as extra requirements we have in place.

1. No person under the age of 17 years shall ride or drive or be in charge of any two or four wheeled motor vehicle during the conduct of an event **(S &R)**
2. No Alcohol is to be consumed by any competitor for a period of 12 hours prior to the event.
Anyone found intoxicated will be barred from competition for the current event. **(S &R)**
3. All competitors will wear long Sleeve Shirts, Long Trousers & covered Shoes. **NO THONGS, SHORTS OR T.SHIRTS.** While competing **(S &R)**
4. Seat belts must be worn & properly adjusted during Competition (Cars only). **(S &R)**
5. The wearing of an approved safety helmet is compulsory for Cars & Motorcycles. **(Our Rules)**
(It is only compulsory for motor cyclists to wear safety helmets S & R)
6. No person under the age of 16 years will be permitted in or near the staging & competition area during the conduct of the event. **(S &R)**
7. No Alcohol is permitted in the competition area during the conduct of the event. **(S &R)**
8. The Maximum speed of any vehicle in the staging area & after leaving the track is 10Kph or walking pace. **(Our Rules)** **S & R regulations are a maximum of 15KPH**
9. Burnouts are not permitted in any other area at the venue other than on the Burnout track. **(S &R)**
10. Only the Driver or Rider is to be in/on a vehicle whilst it is competing. **NO PASSENGERS. (S &R)**
11. Vehicles need not be registered. If vehicle is unregistered, it must be transported to the facility (Not driven). It must also pass scrutineering. **(S &R)**
12. Any competing vehicle failing to keep within the defined track area will be automatically disqualified. **(S &R)**
13. Any one not obeying the rules & conditions of competing in the burn out event or disobeying marshals directions will be banned from competing in the event, may be escorted out of the event & possibly banned from entering any future events. **(Our Rules)**
14. Only one vehicle at a time will compete on the burnout track. **NO PASSANGERS WILL BE ALLOWED. (Our Rules)** **S &R dose allow passengers in vehicles for demonstrations at the moment we prefer not to.**
15. Entrants must obey all directions given by marshals, officials, Fire & safety marshals. **Our Rules**
16. Green flag is to start. **(S &R)**
17. Entrants must stop if given a red flag & wait for further instruction from marshals. **(S &R)**
18. Entrants are disqualified if they are given a black flag, they must stop the burn out & immediately leave the track at a walking pace. Unless told to shut down the engine by fire & safety marshals. **(Our rules)**
19. The entrant is to travel north down the track to the widest area at the bottom of the track do a few full turns & exit the track at a walking pass to a tyre changing area. The Approximate speed of entrants in the burn outs is between a walking pace & 15KPH. **(Our Rules)**

20. Competition must cease if the vehicle moves off the allotted burnout/circle work pad/defined area. The vehicle will be disqualified. **(S &R)**
21. No competitor is to have any part of there body protruding from the vehicle during competition (Cars only). Automatic Disqualification. **(S &R)**
22. During competition, the driver's door must be kept unlocked. **(S &R)**
23. During competition, head lights must be on, if available. **(S &R)**
24. The spinning of tyres is not permitted on any part of the facility whilst not in competition. **(S &R)**
25. Only one vehicle at a time is permitted to compete in the burn outs. **(Our Rules)**
26. No static burn outs will be permitted as it causes damage to the surface of the track. **(Our Rules)**
27. Body Condition of vehicle must be good. No panel damage. **(Our Rules)** **Scrutineering**
28. The drivers seating position (cars only) must have a securely mounted & approved seat belt fitted. **(S &R)**
29. The doors must have secure locking mechanisms. **(S &R)**
30. The Battery must be securely mounted. **(S &R)**
31. The fuel tank, if not original, is to be of a professional construction or fuel cell type & must be securely mounted. **(S &R)**
32. An over flow bottle must be fitted to the vehicles radiator (Cars only). **(Our Rules)**
33. Bonnets & front guards must be fitted (cars only). **(S &R)**
34. Scatter Shields to be fitted to all modified vehicles, fitted with a manual gear transmission. (Cars only). **(S &R)**
35. No fuel or oil to be placed on wheels, either by manual or mechanical application. **(S &R)**
36. All Wheels must have all wheel nuts fitted & secured. **(S &R)**
37. All wheel weights must be removed. **(S &R)**
38. No slick tyres allowed. Drive tyres must have a minimum tread depth. **(S &R)**
39. A minimum of the front brakes must be operational. **(S &R)**
40. All dress rims or hub caps must be removed. **(S &R)**
41. All Cars entering the burn outs must have a 360 degree tail shaft loop fitted just behind the front universal. **A 360- degree loop is compulsory** as it is possible for the tail shaft to spear through the floor of the car. Yes this dose mean Commodores have to have one they do fit. **(Our Rules).**
